ORDER

WHEREAS, the Delaware State Fire Prevention Commission (“the Commission”) has received a copy of Court documentation indicating that on or about June 18, 2010 John D. McElhenny, Jr. was charged with 6 felony counts of Rape in the First Degree under 11 *Del. C.* §773(a)(6) and 3 felony counts of Unlawful Sexual Contact in the Second Degree under 11 *Del. C.* §768; and

WHEREAS, 16 *Del. C.* §6712A (a) provides that the Commission shall issue an Order temporarily suspending the certificate of an ambulance attendant or EMT licensed by the Commission who is charged with a felony pending a final hearing on the complaint.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED this 30th day of June, 2010, that the EMT-B certification of John D. McElhenny, Jr. is temporarily suspended in accordance with 16 *Del. C.* §6712A until a final determination of the case. The Commission shall schedule a hearing within 180 days of the date of this Order of suspension unless an expedited hearing is requested pursuant to the provisions of 16 *Del. C.* §6712A (c).
