**COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY SUSPENSION**

1. Javier Alexander Valcarcel Oquendo (“Respondent”) is a resident of Ellendale, Delaware and is certified as an emergency medical technician (“EMT”) in Delaware pursuant to the provisions of 16 *Del. C.* Ch. 67.

2. Respondent’s EMT certification, I.D. Number 0112296 was originally issued on July 28, 2023, and expired on March 31, 2026.

3. At all times relevant, Respondent engaged in the practice of EMT at Rehoboth Beach Fire Company.

4. On April 7, 2026, Respondent sent two naked images of himself, in which his penis was visible, to a juvenile through Snapchat.

5. After sending the first image, Respondent sent messages to the juvenile apologizing and indicating the picture was not for the juvenile. Shortly thereafter, Respondent sent a second unsolicited naked image of himself to the juvenile.

6. On April 8, 2026, Respondent sent the juvenile a message through Instagram apologizing.

7. Respondent and the juvenile know each other through the fire service.

8. On May 26, 2026, Respondent was arrested on one count of Obscenity Material Provided to a Person Less than 18 years of Age, a felony, in violation of 11 *Del. C.* §1361, case

number 2605013540. Respondent is pending a preliminary hearing on June 18, 2026.

9. Respondent failed to self-report his felony arrest for one count of Obscenity Material Provided to a Person Less than 18 years of Age, a felony, in violation of 11 *Del. C.* §1361, case number 2605013540, to the Fire Commission as required under Regulation 710, Section 18.8.1.1 and 18.8.1.2.

10. Respondent has violated Regulation 710, Section 18.4.1.5 of the Delaware State Fire Prevention Regulations in that he has violated any provision of this regulation.

11. Respondent has violated Regulation 710, Section 18.4.1.7 of the Delaware State Fire Prevention Regulations in that he has engaged in “unprofessional conduct”, specifically Section 18.4.2.3 in that Respondent’s above-described conduct was “dishonorable, unethical, or other conduct likely to deceive, defraud, or harm the public.”

12. Respondent violated Regulation 710, Section 18.8.1.1 in that he failed to submit a self-report to the volunteer fire, rescue or ambulance company, or ambulance service provider to which they are a member or employed and to the Commission of any arrests, convictions, charges or adjudications.

13. Respondent violated Regulation 710, Section 18.8.1.2 in that he failed to submit a self-report as required by Section 18.8.1 in writing within ten (10) days of any arrest or release from state custody.

14. Respondent’s above-described conduct shows that Respondent’s continued practice as a licensed EMT presents a clear and immediate danger to the public health, safety or welfare pursuant to Ambulance Service Regulation 710, Section 18.4.7.

**WHEREFORE**, pursuant to 16 *Del. C.* Ch. 66 and 67, and Regulations 18.4.3 and 18.4.7. the State of Delaware respectfully requests that the Commission:
